

Online

Online provides flexibility for students who cannot attend lectures during traditional office hours or in-person lectures. Students attend synchronous (live on MS Teams) lectures*, on weekdays from 18:00 - 21:00 (SAST) and on Saturdays. Students use our online myLMS portal to access learning materials.

Our online qualifications are available for full-time or part-time study (as outlined below). Full-time students enrol for three or four modules per block, while part-time students typically enrol for one or two modules per block.

As a full-time online student, dedicating sufficient time to studies is essential. Expect a typical workload of at least 120 credits per academic year, which allows for completion of qualifications within the minimum duration: 1 year for a Higher Certificate or Honours degree and 3 years for a Bachelor's degree.

As a part-time student, your workload will typically involve fewer than 120 credits per academic year, enabling you to complete your qualification over a longer period: 2 years for a Higher Certificate or Honours degree and up to 5 years for a Bachelor's degree.

Distance

Our distance learning model empowers students to study at their own pace without attending live lectures. However, optional consultation support sessions with lecturers are available. Students engage with lecturers and classmates through discussion forums on myLMS and access recorded lectures on the platform.

Distance learning is available part-time and full-time for our Higher Certificate in Business Management, Bachelor of Commerce, Bachelor of Commerce in Accounting, Bachelor of Commerce in Law, and Postgraduate Diploma in Accounting.

Academic Calendar and Four-Block Model

Our academic year is divided into four blocks, allowing students to focus on fewer modules at a time to support stronger academic performance. Each block includes seven lecturing weeks, followed by an assessment period. Before lectures commence (week 0), students are required to engage with course content on myLMS. Supplementary assessments are scheduled either before or after the next block, in line with the academic calendar. You can start your studies with our qualification in any of our Block 1, Block 2, Block 3, or Block 4 intakes.

Access Programmes.

Access Programmes are pathways for admission to a bachelor's degree. Students will learn the necessary foundational knowledge and skills required to succeed in the qualification of their choice.

It is designed for students who have obtained a bachelor's pass or an equivalent qualification but do not meet the required subject requirements of their chosen bachelor's degree programme. Upon successful completion, students will gain entry to an Eduvos degree.
